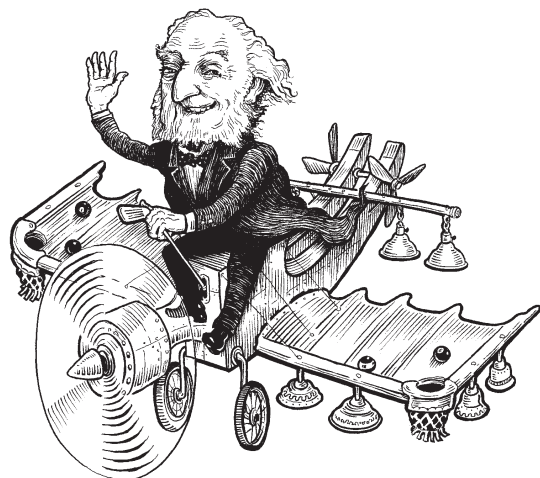

Visit Edgefield for a tour of our distillery in Troutdale, OR

Hogshead Whiskey pure pot distilled from 100% malted barley & aged in new, charred American white oak barrels boasts a palate-pleasing combination of firm grain, hazelnut, sweet vanilla & caramel 8

Aval Pota heart-cut malt whiskey, fresh-pressed apples from Hood River & a touch of cinnamon create a hearty spirit 7.25

Monkey Puzzle our Hogshead Whiskey dry-hopped with local Teamaker hops, sweetened with a touch of honey from Edgefield hives 6.75

Three Rocks Rum a blend of rums aged in our own Hogshead Whiskey & port barrels to create a delicate sipping rum with aromatic complexity & hints of brown sugar, waffle cone & pecans 7.50

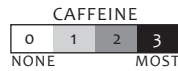

LOOSE LEAF TEA *by Tao of Tea* 3



Emerald Green Green Tea Steep 2-3 min

Made from the small leaf varietal of the tea plant ‘Camellia Sinensis’, this green tea is grown in the northern part of the Zhejiang province - the world’s largest producer of green tea. The brew is ‘Emerald Green’ in color and has a sweet, full bodied flavor with honey aftertaste.

Flavor Profile: Refreshing, sweet pine aroma, toasted, nutty

Moroccan Mint Blended Green Tea Steep 2-3 min

Full-bodied green tea from China blended with flavorful peppermint. Crisp, cooling brew that can be enjoyed either warm or iced. Sweet mint tea is part of life in Morocco and boiled mint tea has been a tradition since ancient times. We have attempted to recreate the Moroccan experience.

Flavor Profile: Roasted, vegetal green tea with fragrant, cooling peppermint.

Kali Cha Oolong Tea Steep 3-4 min

Grown at an altitude of 4800 feet and twenty miles from Darjeeling, the famous tea growing region of India, Kali Cha is one of the first authentic style oolongs from India.

Flavor Profile: Smooth taste with a distinct, toasty aroma of cocoa nibs and peanut shells.

Darjeeling Bergamot Black Tea Steep 3-4 min

Bergamot is a Turkish name given to a pear shaped fruit, Citrus Bergamia, popularly used in Earl Grey tea. Darjeeling Bergamot is a blend of light, crisp, Darjeeling black tea and the essence of bergamot. Fair Trade Certified.

Flavor Profile: Very aromatic, clear and smooth.

Tippy South Cloud Black Tea Steep 3-4 min

Yunnan “South Cloud” is regarded as one of the areas for the Genesis of tea. Made at a 100% organic tea garden with a mix of black and gold tipped leaves. The golden color emerges during processing and adds to the sweetness of the brew.

Flavor Profile: Smooth, dark and slightly smoky.

Cranberry Orange Blended Herbal Tea Steep 2-3 min

Cranberry Orange is an uplifting blend of dried, lightly sweetened cranberries, hibiscus flower petals, chamomile flowers, orange peel and natural orange essence. Carefully hand blended in small batches to ensure consistency.

Flavor Profile: Sweet, fruity, slightly tart taste.

Chamomile Herbal Tisane Steep 3-5 min

Egyptian Chamomile has the largest, brightest flowers with the most fragrance and flavor. A soothing herbal tea to drink anytime of the day, especially relaxing in the evening.

Flavor Profile: Slightly sweet with hints of fruit.

Rooibos 100% Organic Steep 3-5 min

Rooibos is Afrikaans for “Red Bush” and is a member of the legume family of plants. It is commonly used to make a tisane in South Africa. We source our Rooibos directly from one of the pioneers of organic Rooibos processing in South Africa. Made of Superfine Grade, the leaf is fine and thin like needles

Flavor Profile: Smooth, fruity and earthy with a vanilla aroma.

THE HISTORY OF BROADWAY

Overlooking the intersection of NE 15th and NE Broadway is one of McMenamins' little known gems. Hidden in a modern building, the second-story pub has been part of this historic and chic neighborhood since 1990.

From the turn of the century until the early 1950's a house sat at the corner of 15th and Broadway, a house that had at times belonged to two famous families in Portland history, The Barrs and later The Fritzes. The Lloyd Corporation purchased the Fritz home in 1952 and quickly leveled the house. Ralph Lloyd had dreamed of building a vast shopping mall and hotel in Northeast Portland as early as the mid-1920s. His earliest efforts were stifled by the Depression and then WWII, but he resurrected the endeavor in the early '50s. Lloyd died before he realized his dream, but in his memory his four daughters pressed on. In August 1960, the nation's largest urban shopping center to date—and the only one with a skating rink—opened for business with great fanfare, permanently transforming this area.

While huge by 60s standards, the finished shopping center was not as expansive as Ralph's original plan. Much of the real estate his corporation had purchased in the neighborhood became surplus and no longer of use. The cleared lot at NE 15th and Broadway was among this surplus and for years functioned primarily as a parking lot. Every holiday season, though, the corner transformed into a Christmas tree sales lot. For decades folks from this neighborhood returned here year after year to pick their perfect tree, the McMenamin family among them. Mike and Brian McMenamin fondly recall coming annually to the lot around Christmas time.

In late 1989 developers took a fresh look at this underused block, and McMenamins moved in early the next year. At the time it opened McMenamins Broadway Pub was a bit of a departure from our other pubs. Instead of simple burgers, pool tables and psychedelic posters, the Broadway featured skylights, Oriental carpeting, a veritable forest of greenery, and menu selections like the Brie-on-Broadway sandwich. It was the first pub to focus on food service and, as such, altered the face of McMenamins. The second-story atmosphere is unique among McMenamins' locations too, and the place caught on almost immediately. For years it was not uncommon to see lines stretch down the stairs and people milling about waiting for a table. The opening of McMenamins Kennedy School in 1997 humbled its popularity a bit, but the Broadway still remains a busy neighborhood favorite.
